Additions include a larger multi-purpose space to be used for this growth service and for fellowship and youth activities. Renovations include modifications to enlarge the existing sanctuary, and narthex, administration and construction administration.

A new circulation corridor connects the narthex and multi-purpose foyer, giving improved flow and a sense of connection between the formal and the contemporary services. The plan is designed to allow phased construction.

The Mercer Island Presbyterian Church congregation's fastest growing ministry is a "contemporary" worship service, which meets in a multi-purpose space around tables.
