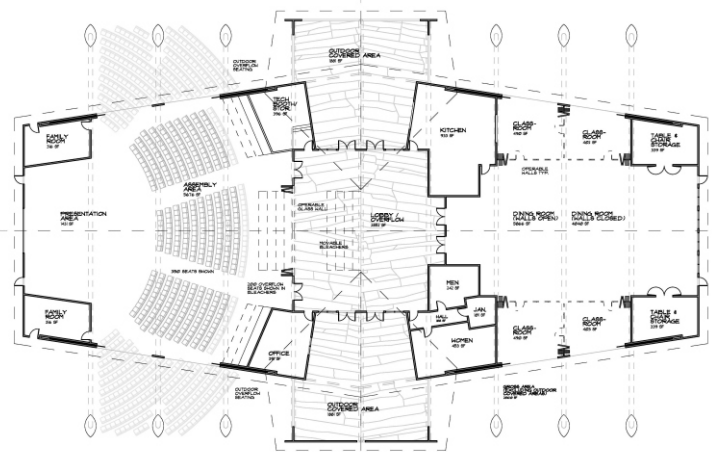


Model - West Side

We have had the honor of working with the Nisqually Tribe on a new multi-denominational Christian church building. They chose BPH Architects because they felt we would listen to them and be responsive to their needs.

And responsive we have been. Although this is our first project for the tribe, we were able to come up with a design that was respectful to their culture and heritage. We incorporated a number of Coast Salish themes such as the canoe shape with the structure extending beyond exterior walls like paddles. We also have included solar panels on the roof in a Nisqually basket weave pattern.

It may be hard to believe, but the images on this page are of the scale model inserted into a picture of the property. This was done to help the tribe visualize the project and build enthusiasm for it.
