This is the second phase for New Community Church at their campus in Maple Valley, the site of the historic Olson Mansion.

We converted the barn to a worship center a couple years before in an award wining adaptive reuse project.

The new building is designed to provide additional meeting space to supplement the barn, which had limited lobby space to work with.

The style is contemporary but it fits well with the barn, using the same roof slope, and same wood siding and steel structure.

One of the most interesting features is the use of overhead bifold doors that allows the space to be completely opened up to the outside. When the doors are open, they form canopies around the perimeter of the building to increase the outdoor covered area for gathering.

There is also a double sided fireplace with one inside and one outside.
